Jane B. Morris Service Fund

Assistance with Utility Bills

Service funds are disbursed on **Tuesdays** from **9:00am – 11:00am** to residents of **Pickens, Liberty, Six Mile, and Sunset.**

Assistance is given **by appointment only.** Please call the church office to set up an appointment with the church's Administrative Assistant.

Guidelines:

1. Utility bill must be paid down to **\$100 or less.**
2. Utility assistance is offered once every **three (3) months.**
3. Pickens Presbyterian pays **\$50 to the utility company.**

You will need to bring:

1. Your bill.
2. A photo ID.
3. Receipts to show the bill has been paid down to \$100 or less (if applicable).

We do not offer assistance with rent.

If you find that you cannot keep your appointment or no longer need your appointment, please call the church office to cancel. This will allow us to schedule someone else to be assisted.

The Fuel Fund

Assistance with Kerosene

Mid-November thru Mid-February Only

Vouchers for fuel are given on **Tuesdays** from **9:00am – 11:00am** to residents of **Pickens, Liberty, Six Mile, and Sunset.**

Guidelines:

1. We provide a **5 gallon voucher** to Lindsay Oil Company.
2. Fuel assistance is only offered from **mid-November** through **mid-February.**
3. Fuel assistance is offered **once per month.**

You will need to bring:

1. A photo ID.
2. Your own container to take to Lindsey Oil to fill with kerosene.

We do not offer assistance with gasoline.

Emergency Food Pantry

Assistance with Groceries

On **Mondays** and **Wednesdays**, residents of **Pickens, Liberty, Six Mile, and Sunset**, can come to the church to receive a box of food.

Our allotted boxes for each day are distributed on a first come, first serve basis. We begin giving out boxes when our office opens at **8:00am.**

Guidelines:

1. **One (1) box of food per household.**
2. A box can be received **once per two week** time period.

You will need to bring:

1. A photo ID.

We cannot hold or "save" boxes of food.

If you would like a list of area churches and organizations which offer assistance with food or utility bill payments, please request one from our Administrative Assistant.
